



CCPTA Partnerships Committee Overview

The purpose of the CCPTA Partnerships Committee is to encourage and facilitate collaboration between Arlington schools and PTAs.

Partnership efforts may include:

- Lasting and meaningful relationships between individual schools
- Joint efforts between schools/PTAs to support initiatives that benefit multiple communities
- CCPTA facilitated programs across Arlington schools/PTAs to support Arlington families and schools

The primary goal of the CCPTA Partnerships Committee is to help Arlington schools and PTAs work together to share resources and support one another.

Established in May 2020 during the current pandemic, the Partnerships Committee has created a centralized list of school support efforts, with the goal to expand its efforts into the 2020-21 school year and beyond with additional initiatives that support collaboration across Arlington schools and PTAs.



CCPTA Summary of School Support Efforts for Arlington Families

- 22 total schools, partnerships, and joint communities currently have support efforts underway.
- 14 schools/communities are providing grocery gift cards to families.
- 16 schools/communities are providing groceries and/or meals to families.
- 13 schools/communities are distributing school supplies and/or other basic needs to families.
- 12 schools/communities are distributing new and/or books in good used condition to students.

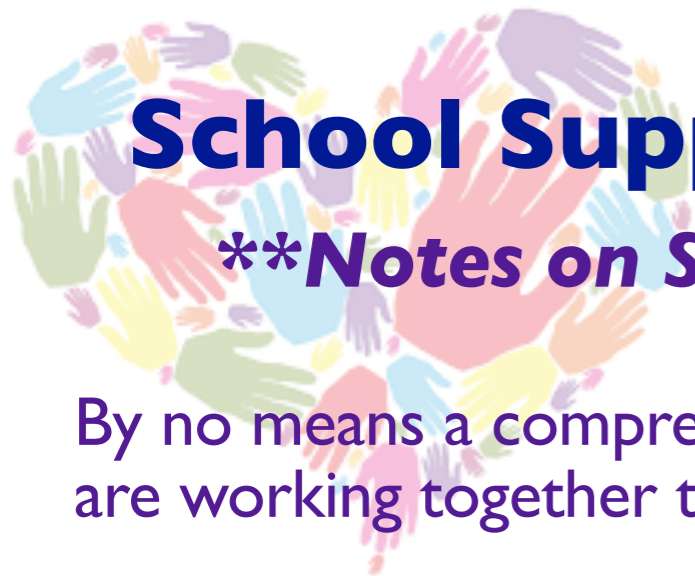

*****Notes on School Partnerships and Joint Communities*****

By no means a comprehensive list, some highlights on the ways schools and communities are working together to support Arlington families:

- Kenmore's school community has partnered with several other school communities and countywide support efforts to host three food and supply distribution efforts, with more planned for this summer, supporting families in the Barcroft, Carlin Springs, Campbell, Hoffman-Boston, and Kenmore communities.
- Abingdon has set up three sites to support the Abingdon, Barcroft, Campbell, and Claremont communities, providing fresh food, hot meals, snacks, supplies, and educational support materials, in addition to a rent relief fund and collection efforts for grocery gift cards and household needs.
- Five PTAs (ASFS, DHMS, Glebe, Key and Taylor) joined forces to coordinate book donation drives for Key's Grab-n-Go and other sites, which has led to a new book donation drive through One More Page Books, online book fairs through R.E.A.D. (Read Early and Daily), and a focus on setting up additional book distribution sites.
- Taylor and Tuckahoe are sponsoring a joint Virtual 5K/IM Fun Run to support the Abingdon, Barcroft, Carlin Springs, and Hoffman-Boston communities.
